## ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISION OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE Community Name: Beaver Creek Township, County: Crawford Ordinance number 38

An ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Beaver Creek located in Crawford County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The Township of Beaver Creek ordains:

**Section 1.** AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b (6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the director of Building & Safety of the County of Crawford is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Beaver Creek under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The County of Crawford assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.

**Section 2.** CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b (6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the Township of Beaver Creek.

**Section 3.** DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "Crawford County, Michigan" and dated 4/17/2012 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map (s) (FIRMS) panel number (s) of 26039C; 0275A; 0300A; & 0325A and dated 4/17/2012 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Building Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2 (1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

**Section 4.** REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5.** PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
