BEAVER CREEK TOWNSHIP CRAWFORD COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDINANCE NO. 37-1A

AMENDMENT TO THE BEAVER CREEK TOWNSHIP SEWER ORDINANCE

This amendment to the Beaver Creek Township Sewer Ordinance clarifies Paragraph No. 1 in Section 6-F "Authority's Responsibility for Repairs, Operation, and Maintenance". The amendment points out the fact that in the project contract between Higgins Lake Utilities Authority and Camp Curnalia, it stipulates that the Authority owns and is responsible for the grinder pump canister and their contests. Further contracts entered into between the Authority and add on users may not include Authority ownership of the grinder pump canister and their contents. The amendment also adds a parenthetical definition of a service connection.

TOWNSHIP OF BEAVER CREEK, CRAWFORD COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

In Paragraph 1 of Section 6-F

The phrase "from the individual grinder pump" is hereby deleted and is replaced by the phrase "including the individual grinder pump".

The words "In the Camp Curnalia..." are hereby added to the beginning of Paragraph 1, Section 6-F.

The parenthetical phrase "(the point where the building sewer connects to the grinder pump canister and its contents)" is hereby inserted in line one of Paragraph 1, Section 6-F, after the words "service connection".

Paragraph 1, Section 6-F now reads as follows:

In the Camp Curnalia pressure sewer system, the public sewer and service connection (the point where the building sewer connects to the grinder pump canister and its contents), will include the sewer facilities in the public and private rights-of-way and the force main including the individual grinder pump to the common force main and the electric service from the connection to the power drop to the individual pump stations.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall take effect the day following the date of publication as required by law.
