ORDINANCE Number: 34**

**EMERGENCY SERVICES RECOVERY ORDINANCE
TRANSPORTATION AND HAZARDOUS MATERIALS**

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH CHARGES FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES under
33 PA 51, as amended. (See MCL 41.801 ff. And MCL 5.2648 ff.)
AND TO PROVIDE A METHOD FOR COLLECTION OF SUCH CHARGES.

SECTION 01: PURPOSE:

This ordinance is adopted to provide financial assistance to the Beaver Creek Fire Department by providing a method for cost recovery from those receiving direct benefits from the emergency services provided by the Department in transportation and hazardous materials incidents.

SECTION 02: LEVELS OF SERVICES PROVIDED:

- 01: WELLNESS:
Road is clear and there are no injuries.
- 02: SECURE THE SCENE:
Debris in the road, assist Law enforcement and check for leaks and spills.
- 03: ASSIST EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES CREW:
Directly involved in patients handling and/or removal.
- 04: SINGLE VEHICLE EXTRICATION
- 05: MULTIPLE VEHICLE EXTRICATION
- 06: SINGLE VEHICLE FIRE
- 07: MULTIPLE VEHICLE FIRE
- 08: COMMERCIAL VEHICLE FIRE
- 09: HAZMAT TRANSPORTATION ACCIDENT
Accident or non-accident releases
- 10: HAZMAT RELEASE
Non transport

SECTION 03: ESTABLISHING FEES:

Fees assessed for the level of services, shall be established by the Township Board.

IT IS MOVED by Balmes and seconded by Riley that this ordinance be adopted.
